Bird Street Road Closure

- Bird Street road closures have been permitted by Westminster City Council until 30/04/25. Closures will take effect during: (exc. bank holidays)
 - Monday - Friday 08:00 to 18:00
 - Saturday - 08:00 to 3:00
 - Road closure licence no. HIGH58397

 - Level 4-7 scaffolding in southeast corner of James and Oxford Streets in line with telecoms restriction.

PLANNED & CURRENT WORKS

Internal demolition, investigative works and maintenance

- Maintenance, refurbishment and installation to lifts.
- Retail area drylining, ceilings and partitions.
- Structural steel infills levels 1 and 2.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday to Friday..... Between 08.00hrs and 18.00hrs

Noisy works, including drilling and cutting into the fabric of the building will be restricted to a two hour on, two hour off protocol. All other construction work will continue throughout the hours of operation.

The building is occupied on levels 4 and 6. Therefore cyclical maintenance works may be carried out, out of hours by the building management.
