## PLANNED SITE SET UP

- Scaffolding and hoarding day works on James, Barrett & Oxford Street continuing.
- Sub-basement scaffolding on Bird Street.
- Bird Street crane lift
- Level 3 scaffold ties



## PLANNED & CURRENT WORKS

### Internal demolition, investigative works and maintenance

- Maintenance, refurbishment and installation to lifts.
- Retail area drylining, ceilings and partitions.
- Structural steel infills levels 1 and 2.

### Other Works

- Phase 1 reception works.
- Level 7 Barrett Street builder's work.
- Level 7 Roof, new timber floor and coping waterproofing.
- Roof terrace plinths, break out and casting of new plinths.
- Barrett Street curtain walling and doors.
- Removal of exterior tiles Barrett & Bird Streets
- Level 1-3 screeding and window installation
- Facade stone repairs.
- Internal demolition
- Internal external brick and blockwork.

## HOURS OF OPERATION

**Monday to Friday** Between 08.00hrs and 18.00hrs

**Saturday** Between 08:00hrs and 13:00hrs

Noisy works, including drilling and cutting into the fabric of the building will be restricted to a two hour on, two hour off protocol. All other construction work will continue throughout the hours of operation.

The building is occupied on levels 4 and 6. Therefore cyclical maintenance works may be carried out, out of hours by the building management.



## HEALTH & SAFETY
